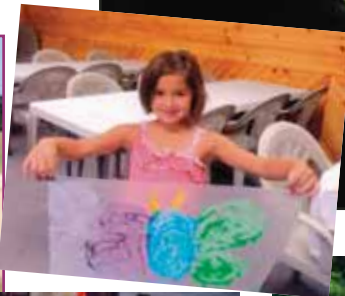
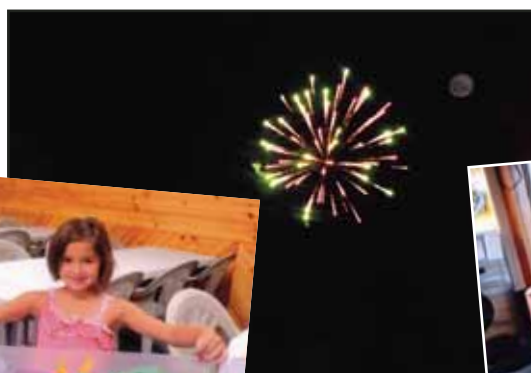

CHECK-OUT - 1:00 P.M. CHECK-OUT - 11:00 A.M.

SPEED LIMIT - MAXIMUM IS 7 MPH.

HOT TUB & POOL - Swim at your own risk - lifeguard is not provided. Children in diapers must wear rubber pants. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. **NO PETS OR GLASS IN POOL AREA.**

CAMPING - 1 family and 1 camping unit per site. "Family" is 2 adults and unmarried children under the age of 18. An extra tent no larger than 8 feet by 8 feet is allowed for children.

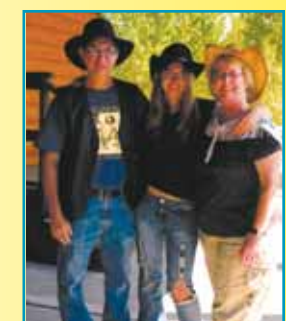

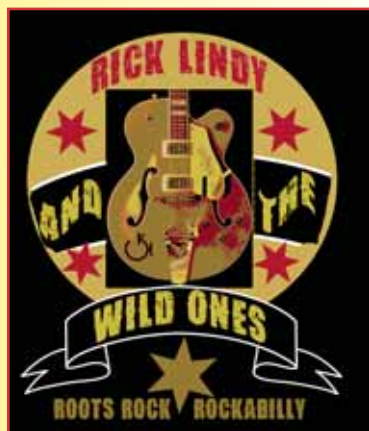

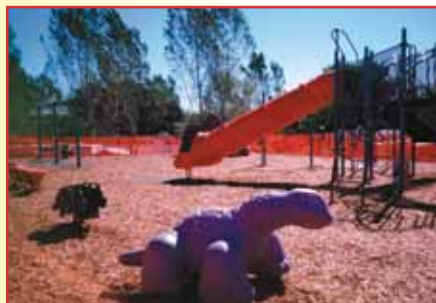
